

Auditor Training Program Recertification

Classroom Course

This one-day Virtual Instructor Led Training program is designed for certified ACSA Auditors to take every three years to maintain their auditor certification. This course will cover updates relating to any recent changes to the audit document and/or processes. It also serves to clarify any issues that auditors have encountered while evaluating health and safety management systems.

- Auditing Theory
- Review of the ACSA Audit Instrument
- Steps in the Audit Process
- Auditor Certification
- Optional Processes

Certification

This course has an individual online open book test and skills check component. Participants must achieve a minimum score of 80% on the online test and complete eight (8) skill checks for course certification. If participants are not successful on the initial test and one (1) rewrite attempt (if eligible), they will be required to take the three day Auditor Training Program and complete a qualification audit to reinstate their auditor certification.
