LIBRARY LOAN CONDITIONS

Eligibility:

- Audio-visual materials are available for use only by *ACSA Members or Associate Members*. A Borrowing Agreement is to be completed and signed to be kept on file per year (or if contact person changes).

Usage:

- No materials shall be reproduced in whole or in part.
- Use or distribution beyond internal company is strictly forbidden.
- Borrower is liable for any infringement while material is in their custody.

Loan Requests & Loan Period:

- Requests may be made in person. Requests by voicemail or e-mail are not confirmed until Library staff contact you. We advise a *minimum notice* of 2 working days (in town), and 3 working days (out of town) before date required.
- Loan period is *2 weeks including shipping*. A one week extension may be possible if requested before due date and if material is not in demand.
- Loans are on a first-come-first-serve basis, maximum of *4 items* at a time.
- Library has the right to limit the number of times an item is requested.

Delivery & Return:

- It is essential to return materials on time in order for us to meet the needs of other borrowers. Continued late return of materials *may result in suspension* of borrowing privileges for 3 months.
- Out-of-town delivery can be arranged via DHL/Loomis or Purolator (customer courier account number required) or to a Greyhound Station. If returning by Greyhound, we ask for "Door to Door" or "Station to Door" service only. The borrower is *responsible for all courier charges*, otherwise the loan is free.
- Greyhound is not recommended during November to the end of February.
- Within the local area, it is the responsibility of borrowers to arrange pick-up and return of all audio visual materials.
- Return items to the location borrowed from.
- *Pack carefully* when shipping long distance. Use a padded envelope or small box.
- *No Canada Post* please – Courier's only. (Borrower pays for all courier charges)

Lost or Damaged:

- In the event of loss, damage or non-returned loans, a replacement fee for each item plus \$10 administration fee will be charged to the borrower or company.
- *No future loans allowed, until payment is received in full.*
- Note the average cost is \$600.00 per DVD and \$495.00 per VHS tape.

Please read Care Tips on the following page. Could save you \$\$.

CARE TIPS

Audio-visual materials are expensive to replace. Please treat our items with care and clean hands so that they will remain a quality resource for all to use.

To protect ALL items from unnecessary damage, note the following:

- Keep away from *extreme heat or cold*: sunlight, dashboards and magnets.
- Always allow item to adjust to room temperature before playing in winter.
- Ensure each item is placed in its proper case and videos rewind.
- When using a "Courier" *Package well*, (padded envelope, not just a thin plastic courier bag).

DVD: *Is more delicate than a CD, treat GENTLY with CLEAN HANDS!*
(smudges or scratches greatly affect play)

- *Press lightly on center hub* to release disc from case. Do not pull on it.
- Avoid flexing or bending disc while removing or inserting in case, this harms the disc by causing stresses and cracks.
- *Do not touch* the playing surface with your fingers.
- Handle disc by the edge and the center.
- Do not stack discs on top of each other, always store in their proper case.
- When returning to case, place a finger on each side of center hub and press *lightly* on disc to be sure it is seated properly in case.
- CDs or DVDs do not require routine cleaning.
- Only if absolutely necessary, a disc may be cleaned by the following:
 - Blow off dust (includes player tray).
 - Use *soft lint-free cloths* (No paper towels/tissue). Gently wipe from center straight toward the outer edge in one smooth stroke.
 - *Never* wipe in a circular direction.

VHS: *ALWAYS place videotapes ON AN EDGE, either bottom or side.*
(laying flat overtime, causes distortion of tape)

- Follow VCR Player instructions and clean player periodically.
- Rewind videos before returning to case.
- **Spine Label** should face towards the fold-down end of plastic case (fits in both ways, but tape is being stretched out of shape if opposite).
- Never place paper between sprocket holes and tape case nubs (use flat side).

Remember do NOT duplicate/store in whole or in part.
