

Hazard Management

Classroom Course

This one-day course has been designed to help participants understand the components and application of a Hazard Management System. This course will review methods for hazard and risk assessment in the context of Alberta Occupational Health & Safety legislation requirements.

Course topics

- Regulatory requirements
- Rights and responsibilities of Employers and Workers
- Hazard assessment tools (Formal and Site-specific Hazard Assessments)
- Applying and monitoring of controls
- Continuous improvement
- Administration of the Work Site Workbook

Certification

This course has a written test and a skills check component. Participants must achieve a minimum score of 80% on a closed-book written test and complete three skill objectives for course certification.
