

## Leadership for Safety Excellence™ (Pre2017)

### Classroom Course

This two-day course is designed to provide participants with tools to integrate into their daily activities to create and promote a healthy and safe working environment. Course materials are geared toward supervisory positions, yet beneficial to all.

### Certification

#### *First Level of the LSE Program - Certificate of Completion*

This course has a written test and skills check component. Participants must achieve a minimum score of 80% on an open-book written test for course certification.

#### *Second Level of the LSE Program - Certificate of Proficiency*

To receive the ACSA LSE Certificate of Proficiency, participants must submit copies of the following documents to the ACSA for review as per the LSE Proficiency submission requirements:

- hazard assessment
- site inspection
- incident investigation
- toolbox talk/safety meeting
