

TDG Train-the-Trainer

Classroom Course

This one-day course is designed for individuals responsible for training workers who may be involved in transporting, handling, shipping, receiving, or supplying dangerous goods in the construction industry. The course is specifically focused on transport by road and does not cover TDG issues related to transport by air, marine, or rail.

Course Topics

- Overview of TDG legislation
- TDG Training requirements
- Classification of dangerous goods and safety marks
- Means of containment
- Documentation
- Emergency Measures and release reporting
- Exemptions

Certification

This course has a written test and a skills check component. Participants must achieve a minimum score of 70% on a closed-book test and complete two skills checks for course certification. Certification allows trainers to conduct TDG training at their work sites using ACSA materials. Trainers must re-certify every three (3) years.
