







Pre-Task	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Select AWP that meets task requirements.</li> <li>• Only operate AWP if authorized and trained to do so.</li> <li>• Review and follow manufacturer's specification for operation, inspection, and maintenance. Never operate equipment that is not working properly or malfunctioning.</li> <li>• Inspect AWP and work area prior to use. Walk travel path.</li> <li>• Ensure ground is firm and level and will support the maximum load and footprint of the equipment including outriggers or extending axles.</li> <li>• Note any power lines, open pits, or excavations in area.</li> <li>• Complete function test using ground controls prior to mounting.</li> </ul>
During	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Only mount AWP when platform is at ground level.</li> <li>• Attach lanyard to an authorized anchor point.</li> <li>• Travel on firm level surface with the platform below the horizontal. Keep hands on the inside guardrail.</li> <li>• Do not operate in windy conditions greater than rated by the manufacturer.</li> <li>• Do not exceed the rated capacity of the AWP at any time.</li> <li>• Do not use other means to increase platform height (e.g., boxes or ladders).</li> </ul>
Post-task	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Only dismount AWP when platform is at ground level.</li> <li>• Store with all booms and platforms lowered and retracted.</li> <li>• Store (park) in a secure well protected area.</li> <li>• Turn machine off and remove key.</li> <li>• Report any mechanical deficiencies for repair or replacement.</li> </ul>
