







Pre-Task	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Consider the task and follow safe job procedures, industry best practices, and legislative requirements.</li> <li>• Complete a hazard assessment and follow the required controls.</li> <li>• Complete WHMIS and site-specific training procedures before using cleaning solvents.</li> <li>• Read the products SDS and follow the required controls.</li> <li>• Hazardous products require storage in a secure location.</li> <li>• Consider the controls and follow requirements for the use of ventilation and PPE.</li> <li>• Complete fit testing for required use of RPE.</li> <li>• Confirm ERP.</li> </ul>
During	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Set up ventilation system prior to using hazardous solvents.</li> <li>• Select and use the appropriate cartridges (RPE) determined for the specific solvent. Not all cleaning solvents use the same cartridges.</li> <li>• Always use the required PPE including gloves, respirators, eye protection and body protection.</li> <li>• Use non-flammable solvents for general cleaning whenever possible.</li> <li>• Always use approved containers when decanting solvents.</li> <li>• Label containers appropriately prior to filling them.</li> <li>• Do not eat or smoke while using solvents.</li> </ul>
Post-task	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• When complete, return unused solvent to secure location.</li> <li>• Clean area and dispose of any contaminated rags, gloves, or cloths according to the SDS, company policy, and local authority requirements.</li> <li>• Wash hands and any affected body parts upon task completion.</li> </ul>
