







Pre-Task	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure worker is competent to operate the crusher.</li> <li>• Follow all manufacturer's specifications and procedures for crushing operations.</li> <li>• Inspect critical components, conveyor belts, hoppers, cones, and tracks for portable crushers.</li> <li>• Complete a hazard assessment and follow required controls. Include all mobile equipment, such as loaders feeding the crusher.</li> <li>• Ensure all guards have been placed as per manufacturer's requirements.</li> <li>• Confirm all emergency trip cables function prior to start up.</li> </ul>
During	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Follow manufacturer's procedures for primary, secondary, and screening operation.</li> <li>• Wear the appropriate PPE such as respirator, glasses, and hearing protection.</li> <li>• Never exceed recommended aggregate size.</li> <li>• If crusher jams or build up occurs, lock the equipment out. Never access panels to clear debris while the crusher is active.</li> <li>• Do not climb over or duck under conveyors while in motion.</li> <li>• Ensure lubrication, flow, temperature, wear, and pressure are monitored through use.</li> </ul>
Post-task	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Loader operators should maintain proper housekeeping.</li> <li>• Back blade access roads to maintain route integrity.</li> <li>• Lock and tag out any defective equipment and ensure competent persons maintain the equipment.</li> </ul>
