







Pre-Task	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consider the task and follow safe job procedures, industry best practices, and legislative requirements. • Familiarize yourself with driving laws, company procedures, and manufacturers recommendations prior to driving. • Ensure you have a valid operator's licence. • Ensure you are fit to drive, sober, and well rested. • Complete a walk around inspection of the vehicle prior to driving. • Plan route. Consider road conditions, weather, traffic patterns and time of day
During	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Practice defensive driving. • Do not drive while distracted. (Refer to SWP 0068) • Drive within the vehicle's capabilities. • Do not use cell phone or only hands-free options if allowed. • Do not pick up hitchhikers or strangers. • Back in whenever possible.
Post-task	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bring vehicle to a complete stop and place in park before the driver or passengers exit the cab. • Park vehicle in a safe and secure location. • Maintain vehicle to ensure optimal safety.
